
Balti Municipality

 Balti Municipality is a major industrial, cultural and commercial center and transportation hub in the north region of the Republic of Moldova, also called "the northern capital". It is the second largest municipality in terms of area, economic importance, and population after the capital Chisinau. The total number of permanent inhabitants amount to 151,3 thousand people. Balti Municipality is located 65 km from the border with Romania-European Union (Sculeni customs) and 120 km from the border with Ukraine (Otaci customs). Several Department within City Hall of Balti Municipality will provide necessary skills in the implementation period, among which mostly the Foreign Relations and Attracting Investments Department, which has a tremendous experience in the external funds/projects attraction and management.
